Outdoor Adventures Kick Off

The 4th annual Outdoor Adventures Kick Off was held on April 30th. The Licking Park District and several organizations are encouraging children and adults to turn off their tablets, televisions, smart phones, and gaming consoles for one week. With screens off, children and adults can instead be physically active, read, play, create, and spend time with friends and family. There was a rock climbing wall, geocaching, bounce house, disc golf course, canoe and kayak, crafts, horses and a bee display etc. We set up our OHC display, which included information, coloring sheets (parts of the horse & saddles), and picture opportunity for parents. We set up 3 saddle racks with saddles for the children to climb on and see what it felt like to be in the saddle. We are not allowed to give rides because of insurance purposes. We had 1 rope and this seemed a big hit to the kids. Some boys really got into pretending to rope a steer. Next year it was discussed we should bring hay bales, steer heads, and more ropes for the kids to practice their roping abilities. Beth Webb brought her 2 horses (1 was a mini horse) and corral. This worked very well thanks Beth; members helped the kids pet the horses. Everyone had a good time until the RAIN came and the crowd left.
